MAR. 12 (F) E – 81	<p>ARGUMENTS – LAST DAY TO SUBMIT</p> <p>Last day to submit arguments for or against any county, district or school measure. Arguments may not exceed 300 words in length. (E. C. §§ 9501 and 9502)</p> <p>EXCEPTION: Provisions regarding word limitations do not apply to measures on school district reorganizations. (Ed. C. § 35758)</p> <p>IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS – LAST DAY TO SUBMIT</p> <p>Recommended last day for County Counsel to transmit impartial analysis of any school measure. (E. C. § 9500)</p>
MAR. 13 (Sa) MAR. 22 (M) E – 80 E – 71	<p>PUBLIC EXAMINATION FOR BALLOT MEASURE MATERIALS</p> <p>During this period the elections official shall make available for public examination a copy of any ballot measure text, impartial analysis, argument, or bond statement if applicable, for any school measure. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the materials. During this period any person may file a writ of mandate or an injunction to require any or all of the material to be amended or deleted. (E. C. § 9509)</p>
MAR. 22 (M) E – 71	<p>REBUTTALS – LAST DAY TO SUBMIT</p> <p>Last day for authors of arguments for or against a county, school or district measure to submit rebuttals. Rebuttals may not exceed 250 words in length. (E. C. § 9504)</p>

MAR. 23** (Tu) E – 70**	APR. 1 (Th) E – 61	PUBLIC EXAMINATION PERIOD FOR REBUTTALS During this period, rebuttals for measures shall be available for public examination. A fee may be charged to any person obtaining a copy of the material. During this period, any person may file a writ of mandate or an injunction to require any or all of the material to be amended or deleted. (E. C. § 9509)
MAY 11 (Tu) E – 21		MAILING OF OFFICIAL SAMPLE BALLOT BOOKLETS (Historically commencing at E-40) An Official Sample Ballot Booklet shall be mailed to each voter in the jurisdiction no later than 21 days before the election. (E. C. § 13303)
MAY 17 (M) E – 15		CLOSE OF REGISTRATION Last day to transfer or register to vote in the election. (E. C. §§ 2102 (a) and 2107) PROCESSING VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS The processing of vote by mail ballots may commence on the 10th business day before the election but the results of the tally shall not be released until after the polls close. (E. C. § 15101(b))
MAY 18 (Tu) E – 14	JUNE 1 (Tu) 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY	NEW CITIZEN REGISTRATION/VOTING A new citizen is eligible to register and vote at the office of, or at another location designated by, the county elections official at any time beginning on the 14th day before an election and ending at the close of polls on the election day following the date on which that person became a citizen. (E. C. § 3500)
MAY 22 (Sa) E – 10		TALLY CENTER LOCATION – PUBLICATION On or before this date a notice specifying the public place to be used as the central tally location for counting the ballots shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation within the jurisdiction. (E. C. § 12109 and Govt. § 6061)

**May 22, and 29 (Saturday) and May 23 and 30 (Sunday) office will be closed.

<p>JUNE 1 (Tu) 8:00 P.M. ELECTION DAY</p>	<p>ELECTION DAY Polls open 7:00 a.m., close 8:00 p.m. (E. C. §§ 1201 and 14212)</p> <p>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS RETURNED — 8:00 P.M. Last day for Vote By Mail ballots to be received or turned in personally by the voter at any polling place in the jurisdiction. An authorized representative may return the voted ballot under specified conditions. (E. C. §§ 3017 and 3020)</p> <p>Any Vote By Mail ballot cast under this division shall be timely cast if it is received by the voter's elections official via the United States Postal Service or a bona fide private mail delivery company no later than three days after election day in addition to the provisions set forth in E. C. 3020, Sections 1 and 2. (E. C. § 3020(b) Section 1 and 2)</p>
<p>JUNE 3 (Th) E + 2</p>	<p>OFFICIAL CANVASS The canvass of election returns shall commence no later than the first Thursday following the election. (E. C. § 15301)</p>
<p>JUNE 14 (M) E + 13</p>	<p>COMPLETION OF OFFICIAL CANVASS The county elections official shall prepare a certified statement of the results of the election and submit it to each jurisdiction within 30 days of the election. (E. C. § 15372)</p> <p>NOTE: On Monday, June 14, 2021 the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is tentatively scheduled to certify the election results. On Tuesday, June 22, 2021 the Board of Supervisors is tentatively scheduled to declare the election results official. (E. C. § 15400)</p>
