Semi-Official Results Announced for March 2 Special Elections

LOS ANGELES – Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) Dean C. Logan announced semi-official results for the March 2 Special Elections.

A total of **62,655** ballots were processed and counted, with **10.35%** of eligible registered voters casting ballots across all districts.

After Election Day there are still outstanding ballots to be counted. During our Official Election Canvass, all Conditional Voter Registration ballots, Provisional ballots, and Vote by Mail ballots received on Election Day are processed. Once the ballots are verified, they will be counted.

Ballots postmarked by Election Day must be returned to our Norwalk Headquarters within three (3) days of Election Day to be counted.
